Gather with **intention.**

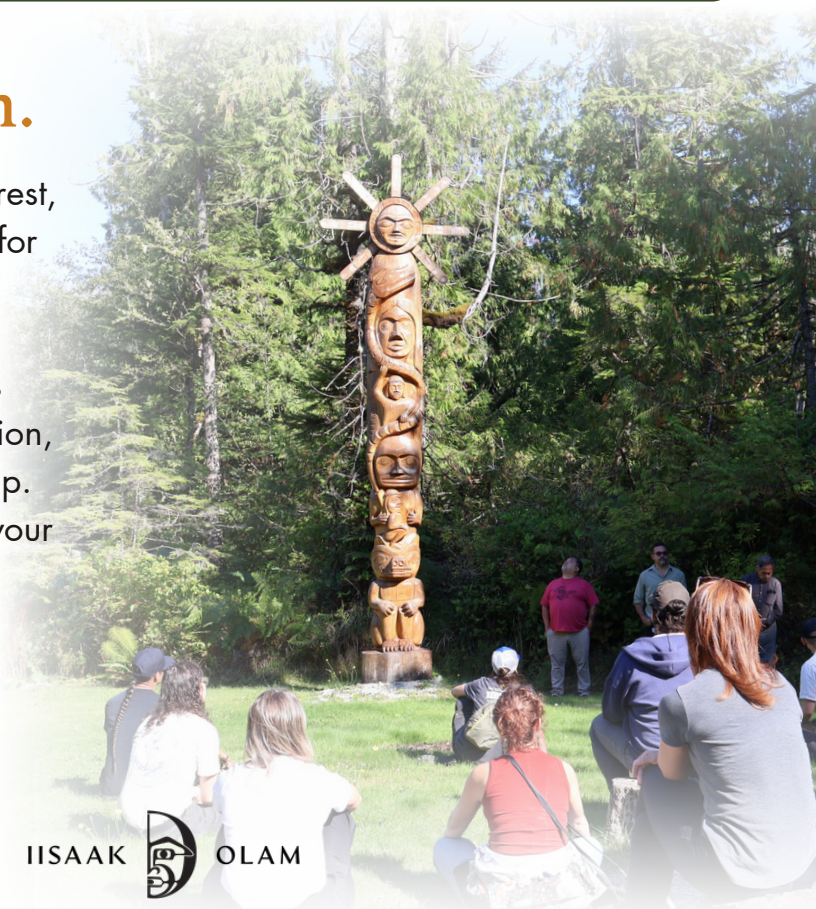

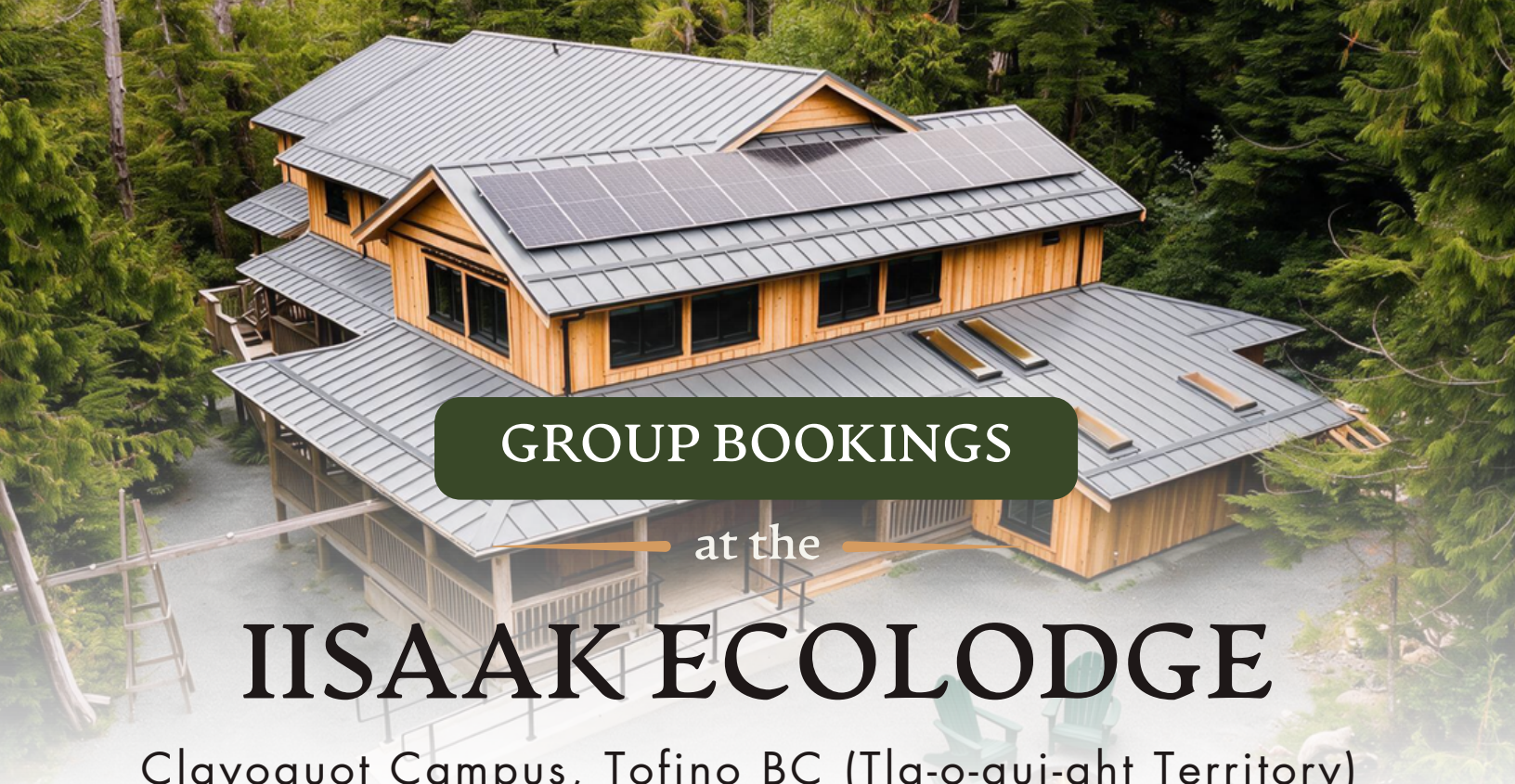
